Annual Healthcare Error Statistics

- An estimated 400,000 people die due to preventable medical errors
- Prescription drugs have killed more people than car accidents
- 10,000 serious complications result from medical mistakes
- 1 out of every 5 diagnoses are incorrect
- Over 100 thousand deaths from hospital acquired infections
- 50,000 to 100,000 deaths annually from diagnostic errors
- Autopsies show that doctors misdiagnose fatal illnesses about 20% of the time
- Thousands more deaths from lack of evidence-based therapies/improper treatment, such as wrong medications or wrong medical procedures
- Countless others are harmed through errors resulting from poor documentation and the difficulty in accessing health information/records
